



Timeline of Assessments

Spring of 1st Grade Year

GRS completed by 1st grade teachers



September of 2nd Grade Year

CogAT is administered to all 2nd graders




Mid-October of 2nd Grade Year

CogAT results are returned and shared with schools and families



October/ November of 2nd Grade Year

ITBS is administered to students who meet criteria



January of 2nd Grade Year

Portfolios are scored and AIG eligibility is determined.



March of 2nd Grade Year

CogAT is administered to new-to-CMS 2nd graders



March/April of 2nd Grade Year

EL/TD Portfolio scoring takes place to determine placement of ELs.
